A traditional favourite with chunks of rhubarb and apples, finished with crumble topping.

COOKING/SERVING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Remove from packaging while frozen.
2. Cut into required portions using a sharp knife dipped in hot water.
3. Cover and return unused frozen portions to the freezer immediately.
4. Thaw each slice in the refrigerator (at less than 5°C) for approx. 2 hours before serving.

To serve warm:

1. Microwave from frozen for approx. 40 seconds per slice.
2. Or once thawed, heat in oven at 180°C for approx. 15 mins.

Crumble can also be spooned out when serving at chilled temperatures.
All ovens vary in performance so temperature and times are only a guide.

INGREDIENTS: Apple (28%), rhubarb (25%), sugar, wheat flour (thiamine), water, margarine [vegetable oil, water, salt, milk solids, emulsifiers (vegetable – 471, 472c), natural flavour, natural colour (carotene)], thickener (1412), dextrose, citric acid, salt.
